STAFF	<p>The school has a staffing complement of 32.42 FTE teachers including the Head Teacher, 1 Depute Head Teacher (school) 1 Depute Head Teacher (CCC) and 3 Principal Teachers.</p> <p>The leadership structure within Carlibar Communication Service is currently under review in order to take account of the increased service being provided.</p> <p>The Nursery is staffed by 1 Principal Teacher, and 1 Nursery Teacher.</p> <p>Support staff consists of 3 Janitors, 4 Clerical Assistants, 28 Pupil Support Assistants (PSA), 11.5 Child Development Staff, 3 Early Years Play Workers plus catering and cleaning staff.</p>
ROLL	232 mainstream pupils, 100 nursery children, 17 part-time pupils in the Pre School Assessment Development Unit (PSADU) and approximately 82 pupils attend the school's Communications Centre on a part-time and full-time basis. A further 30 pupils are supported on an Outreach basis.
SITUATION	Carlibar Primary School Campus is situated in the centre of Barrhead close to rail and bus routes. Barrhead is currently an area of regeneration and benefits from a new Health Centre and the Barrhead Foundry (Sports and Leisure Complex).

BUILDING

The school is a modern state of the art 2 storey building with modern facilities for all areas of the curriculum. The building was officially opened on 26 November 2006 and it caters for boys and girls of all religions from Nursery to Primary 7.

The school has two special units:

Pre School Assessment and Development Unit (PSADU) and
Carlibar Communication Centre (CCC)

Both of these units help children with language and communication difficulties, autistic spectrum disorders and provide nurture support.

The classrooms are traditional in size and designed with internal cloakroom facilities. Each classroom is equipped to the highest possible standard.

CATCHMENT

The main catchment area is currently undergoing an extensive modernisation programme and the school is surrounded by local authority and private housing.

GENERAL

Carlibar Communication Support Service (CCS) supports children from schools across East Renfrewshire. There are very effective partnerships in place with a range of agencies.

The school has an active Parent Council. Parental involvement and engagement in learning is encouraged at all times. We place a high priority on establishing good working partnerships between home and school life.

We have an on-going policy of encouraging links with the local community and the children regularly participate in community projects.

Extra-curricular activities are well established in the school and all children have the opportunity to attend after-school clubs.

The Campus is within walking distance of local parks, and woodland areas. This allows our pupils to access the outdoors on a regular basis. Woodland Adventures for pre-5 children are well established. We also have orienteering courses in and around the school grounds for the P1 – P7 children. We are continuing to develop our school grounds to provide more opportunities for outdoor play and learning about the environment through a range of gardening and nature inspired activities.

The school is excellently resourced to support digital learning and is a Digital School Scotland where there is a focus on digitally enhanced teaching and learning to helping our children and young people prepare for living and working in the 21st Century. The school is currently working towards the Special Recognition for Cyber Resilience and Internet Safety. Resources include a Promethean board or Interactive Panel in every classroom, an ICT suite, Chromebook trolley for every stage, some iPads virtual reality headsets and a range of coding equipment.
